Diversity & Inclusion Statement

1. **Diversity** is about understanding, accepting, and valuing differences between people including those:
 - of different races, ethnicities, genders, ages, religions, disabilities, and sexual orientations
 - with differences in education, personalities, skill sets, experiences, and knowledge bases.
2. An **inclusive** environment is collaborative, supportive, respectful and increases the participation and contribution of all participants.

Long form:
